You are shown a window listing avaiable repeats for this patient. Click the line(s) you wish to issue (control-click to select multiple lines), then click the *Process repeats* button to create new transaction lines for the repeats you have highlighted.

Editing repeat details

Normally the repeat details will not need changing. If they do you can double-click the prescription line and change details.

Note that the *Repeats left* field will show that you are editing a repeat. The quantity left is the quantity after the current repeat has been issued
